To Whom it May Concern,

This letter is to establish the medically necessity of treatment for **Patients Name**. On **xx/xx/xx Patients Name** presented to **Provider Name** as an **Patient Age** year old suffering from an acute case of **Ameliogenesis Imperfecta (K00.5)**. To date **she/he** has lost several teeth and **her/his** few remaining teeth have a very poor prognosis. She/he is unable to eat anything other than soup or soft pasta and choking is a constant fear.

According to the *Oxford Journal* article from December 4, 2013 cites, "AI (Ameliogenesis Imperfecta) was considered as a dental disease, but in light of recent studios, it should be accepted as a systemic medical disease." Two other reference articles the *International Journal of Clinical Dental Science* August 2011 and the *Journal of International Dental and Medical Research* dated August 2011 and the *Journal of International Dental and Medical Research* dated March 1, 2012 cite the same conclusion. There are many more studies available regarding the correlation between AI and systemic medical disease.

We have enclosed a radiograph to show the deterioration that **Patients Name** has been experiencing since **period of time** and has now taken a turn for the worse.

The treatment recommendation is to extract (41899 or D7210) her remaining 8 teeth, a sinus augmentation (21127), bonegraft (21210 and 21215); place 8 dental implants (21249) (4 maxillary 4 mandibular) with full arch implant supported denture.

As you might well guess, this is traumatic for a young woman of 18 to undergo, yet we believe this will restore her form and function with an excellent long term prognosis.
